

**DUKE OF WELLINGTON'S REGIMENT (WEST RIDING)**

**GUIDANCE NOTES FOR ITEMS TO BE SOLD BY AUCTION**

**Outline of Auction**

Items are being offered on a silent bid basis. After the final bidding date all received will be logged and sold to the highest bidder.

All silver items have a minimum sale valuation based on the valuation of the silver by weight that the item would fetch if sold to a silver dealer. Some property items also have a minimum sales value.

All bids for those items with a minimum valuation will need to be in excess of this valuation.

Several serials at the end of the catalogue, serials 86 – 99 (spoons, forks etc), are being sold at a fixed price per individual item. Please indicate on the bidding form how many of each item you would like. They will be allocated on a first come first served basis. So if you are interested in any of these get your bid in early.

**Who may Bid.**

Bids may only be submitted by members of the Regimental Association (i.e. those who have served in the regiment as Regulars or in the TA/Reserve or any unit which had DWR in its title) or their immediate family members.

**Bidding Process and Bidding Form.**

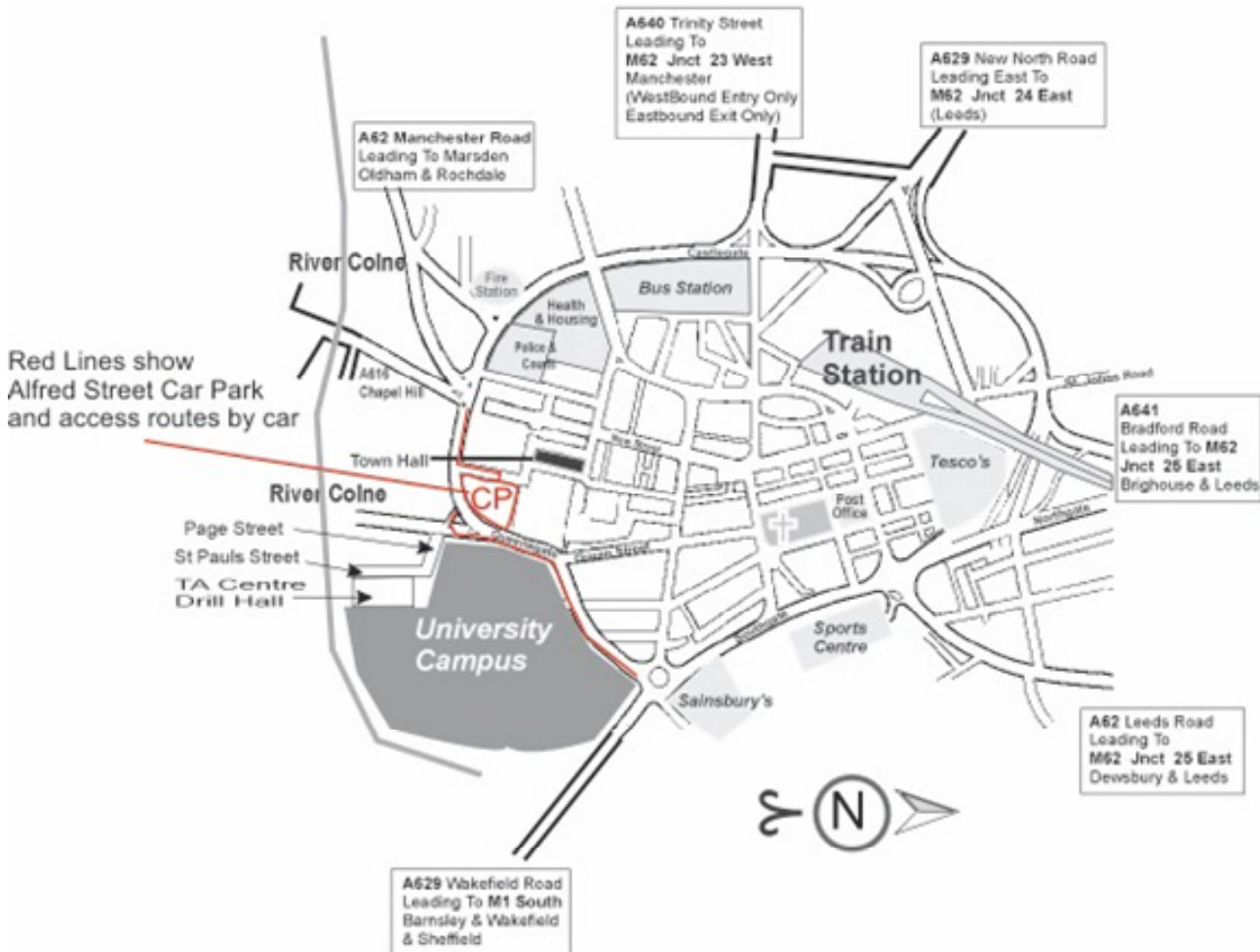
